Dear Parents,

This year we have a brand new topic for the children to learn about in history - Titanic. The teachers are very excited to teach this and we are sure the children will love it. To make the topic come alive, we have booked a trip to a new venue - SeaCity, which is in Southampton, on Thursday 4th June. The teachers have already visited and we are sure the children will have a wonderful day. There will be time to explore the exhibits as well as take part in some fantastic guided sessions, where the children will learn about life in the early 1900s, what the Titanic would have looked like as well as the events that took place, resulting in the sinking of the legendary, unsinkable ship.

On the day, we ask that the children arrive in school at 8:30am to ensure we are ready to depart from Westfields as soon after 9:00am as possible; we will travel by coach provided by Farnham Coaches. We intend to return to school by 3:15pm however, as traffic is unpredictable, a text will be sent to confirm our arrival time back at school if this differs significantly. Children will need to wear their school uniform with sensible shoes e.g. trainers for comfort. Children will also need to bring a packed lunch (no chocolate, sweets or nuts!) together with enough to drink (no fizzy drinks please) in a named lunch bag.

If your child needs any medication for travel sickness or prescribed medicine during the day, please complete and return a named medication form which is available from the school office or our website. All medicine must be handed to a staff member before or on the day of the trip, be in the original container/packaging with a clearly marked expiry date, be in date and contained in a clear plastic bag with your child's name and class.

The cost for the trip to SeaCity Museum including the workshop and coach is £22 per child. This can be paid via Arbor or handed to your child's teacher in a named envelope. This is a voluntary contribution however, if we do not have enough contributions, the trip will not be able to take place. If you have any questions about the trip or if you are able to help and you have a DBS with us, we would be grateful for your support; this can be arranged by contacting your child's class teacher as soon as possible.
