Dear Parents,

We would like to let you know that we have had notification that Hampshire County Council Highways will soon be carrying out essential footway resurfacing works in our local area.

As such we wanted to share the details we have been given with you as we are always mindful of school traffic and the safety of our pupils and families:

The project is scheduled to begin on Monday 8 December 2025 and is expected to last around 19 weeks, with a two-week break over Christmas. For safety reasons, road and footway closures will be in place each day from 7.30am to 6.00pm.

To help reduce disruption, the works will be completed in phases, with each section of road closed in turn. Access will be restricted during working hours.

Phase 1: 8 December 2025 – 20 January 2026
Aylesham Way between Firgrove Road and Selwyn Drive

Phase 2: 21 January 2026 – 18 February 2026
Aylesham Way between Selwyn Drive and Mallard Way

Phase 3: 19 February 2026 – 30 March 2026
Aylesham Way, including Turnstone End, between Mallard Way and Partridge Avenue

Phase 4: 31 March 2026 – 5 May 2026
Aylesham Way between Partridge Avenue and the end of the cul-de-sac

To allow the work to progress smoothly and avoid delays, please ensure no vehicles are parked in the affected areas during working hours.

We understand that these works may cause some inconvenience; however, they are necessary to improve the safety and condition of the footways in our community. We are grateful for your patience and cooperation throughout this period.

*Whilst there is an allowance within the time periods shown above for delays there may be times when we have to postpone works at very short notice; based on the latest weather forecasts, this can occur just prior to works commencing. We will always look to provide up to date information wherever we can, but sometimes last-minute decisions can be difficult to relay to the travelling public in a timely manner. **When we can, any significant changes to the scheduled dates will be made clear on the yellow sign boards located at the works limits.***

*In order to help us to complete the work as quickly as possible, please ensure that no vehicles are parked near the area of works during working hours. **Please be aware any vehicles left parked on the road that prevent the works taking place, face the risk of being removed.***

The surfacing operation uses a separate bitumen layer in addition to the new asphalt footway surface. In order to avoid potential injury or damage, please do not walk across the footway during the works unless directed by a member of the workforce.

For your safety and that of our workforce, we are unable to guarantee vehicular access to and from your property during the closure. Should you need to make an essential journey, please contact a member of the workforce in advance and they will be able to advise if they can accommodate your request.
