

#### Key dates for a happy start...

- ✓ Transition Meetings with pre-schools
- ✓ Familiarisation Visit (26<sup>th</sup> June or 3<sup>rd</sup> July)
- ✓ Home Visits (4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Sept)
- ✓ Class Visits (9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Sept)
- ✓ First day of school (11<sup>th</sup> Sept)



#### Familiarisation Visits...



➤ 26<sup>th</sup> June or 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 10.45am – 11.45 am

Visit of one hour to your child's new class with one adult to stay.



▶9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> September

Class visits, children only in small groups for a one hour session.



#### Home Visits...

✓ Each family will have the opportunity of a home visit from your child's teaching staff team on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup>, Friday 5<sup>th</sup> or Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September.

✓ Details in your pack explain how to book a convenient visit time.

#### Curriculum Information...

- ✓ We continue the EYFS Curriculum (larger scale, not keyworkers)
- ✓ We deliver the curriculum through practical and play activities
- ✓ We teach reading, spelling and handwriting through the Little Wandle phonics programme
- ✓ Assessments are carried out throughout the year through observations







## At the start of the day...

- ✓ If you are early, please wait without allowing your child and sibling to play on equipment or with learning resources (health and safety!)
- ✓ Come to your child's classroom door kiss and drop...
- ✓ Remember to provide your child with water bottle, book bag and coat (named!)
- ✓ Do not worry... if your child is unsettled at drop off this is quite common!

## A typical day in Reception...

- ✓ Little Wandle Phonics
- ✓ Reading
- ✓ Drawing Club
- ✓ Story & Snack
- ✓ Milk time
- ✓ Maths Activity
- ✓ Must-do Jobs (with an adult)
- ✓ Outside and inside continuous provision



#### **Lunch Information**

Children eat all together in the hall Choice of free school meal or packed lunch

#### **Universal Free School Meal:**

Meat, vegetarian or jacket potato option



#### **Packed lunches:**

- Easy to open/eat food
- ✓ No nuts
- ✓ No sweets/chocolate bars/fizzy drinks



## At the end of the day...

- ✓ Collect from your child's classroom door (gates open from 3.05pm)
- ✓ A member of staff will dismiss your child when they see you there.
- ✓ You can allocate other adults to collect your child but staff must be informed to support safeguarding.
- ✓ Please use the class diary to make a note of any changes to the person collecting or phone school office.

## Preparing for school...



#### Encourage your child to be able to independently:

- ✓ dress and undress
- ✓ use the toilet (and wash hands)
- ✓ share and take turns (play and conversation)
- ✓ share and talk about books Active Reading
- ✓ be able to use cutlery and have good table manners.

- ✓ Meet the Teacher Session Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2.30pm

#### Medical Matters

- ✓ Any viral/infectious sickness or diarrhoea, must be followed by 48 hours absence.
- ✓ Any absence requires an email or telephone call providing reason by 9.00am on day of absence (safeguarding procedures).
- ✓ Headlice are common! Please check regularly and treat as recommended tied up long hair supports this!
- ✓ Medicines can only be administered by prior arrangement.
