## Medical Matters

 Any viral/infectious sickness or diarrhoea, must be followed by 48 hours absence.

✓Any absence requires an email or telephone call providing reason by 9.00am on day of absence (safeguarding procedures).

✓Headlice are common! Please check regularly and treat as recommended – tied up long hair supports this!

✓ Medicines can only be administered by prior arrangement.

- 12noon Lunchtime school dinners or packed lunches (no nuts or chocolate bars)
- $\checkmark$  Outside and inside continuous provision
- ✓ 3 15pm Collection from classroom doors









## At the start of the day...

Come to your child's classroom door.

 Remember to provide your child with water bottle, book bag and coat (named!)

Do not worry... if your child is unsettled at drop off – this is quite common!

## At the <u>end</u> of the day...

Collect from your child's classroom door.

A member of staff will dismiss your child when they see you there.

 You can allocate other adults to collect your child but staff must be informed to support safeguarding.

Please use the class diary to make a note of any changes to the person collecting or phone school office.
