Recognising Different Sounds Recognising one or many voices singing a song and identifying instruments playing in various pieces of music - such as piano, drums, guitar.	Inventing a Musical Story Playing an instrument, demonstrating dynamics, rhythm, pitch and duration to create a feeling or mood for a story/song.	Explore Improvisation Improvising with tuned and untuned percussion, being able to play three or more notes to improvise to a familiar piece of music.
