Dear Parents,

As part of our Year R Transport Topic, the children have begun learning about different forms of transport. In order to bring to life our study we would like to provide the children with an opportunity to participate in a day visit to Bekonscot Model Village on Wednesday 15th May 2024.

Our children will spend their day exploring the village as well as attending a workshop identifying the different forms of transport available in the 1930s.

On the day, children will come into school at 8.40am to ensure they are ready to depart from Westfields soon after 9:00am by coach. We intend to return to school by 3.15pm however as traffic can be unpredictable, a text will be sent to confirm our arrival time back at school <u>if</u> this differs significantly. Children will need to wear their school uniform with sensible shoes and have clothing appropriate for the weather, eg waterproof coat, sun hat, sun cream. Children will also need to bring a packed lunch (no chocolate, sweets or nuts!) together with enough to drink (no fizzy drinks please) in a small named lunch bag. No rucksacks please.

If your child needs any medication for travel sickness or prescribed medicine during the day, please complete and return a named medication form which is available from the school office or our website. All medicine must be handed to a staff member before or on the day of the trip, be in the original container/packaging with a clearly marked expiry date, be in date and contained in a clear plastic bag with your child's name and class.

The cost for the trip to Bekonscot including the workshop and coach is £21.00 per child. This can be paid via Arbor or handed to your child's teacher in a named envelope. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not have enough contributions, the trip will not be able to take place. Please complete the following online form <u>Bekonscot Online Form</u> by Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

If you have any questions about the trip, or if you are able to help and you have a DBS with us we would be grateful for your support; this can be arranged by contacting your child's class teacher as soon as possible. As we hope this to be very popular, your child's class teacher will then contact you to confirm – thank you in anticipation of your support.
