Dear Parents,

Today, you will receive via 'pupil post' your child's 'Attainment and Progress Tracker' which has been completed by their class teacher and which includes the following information:

An indication of what your child is currently 'on track' to achieve at the end of this academic year. This judgement shows what your child is currently 'on track' to achieve at the end of this academic year so you can see whether they are currently not on track to meet end of year expectations for their year group, on track to meet or on track to achieve a greater depth. Please note, that as the year progresses, this can change because children learn and progress at different rates. This current indication is based on your child's learning on a daily basis together with assessments of what they have learnt and understood so far during this academic year.

For children who are not on track to meet their year group's end of year expectations, they will be receiving additional support in the form of extra time with the teacher or support staff in and out of the classroom and/or through weekly intervention groups. Any additional support at home would also be beneficial and if you would like further information as to how best to support your child, please contact their class teacher to discuss this.

Current key targets

In order to clarify what the children's individual next steps are, targets have been identified, taken from key areas of learning for reading, writing and maths as well as general targets to support learning. We hope that this information will enable you to support your child further at home.

The intention of providing this information is not only to continue to keep you informed of your child's attainment but also support us to work in partnership with you to encourage them towards future success and achieving their full potential.

Your child's attainment and the progress they make is hugely supported by attendance so you are also being provided with your child's attendance certificate for the autumn term. Please also be aware that at any point you can check your child's current attendance rate on Arbor.

As always, if you have any questions or require any support, please do ask your child's class teacher.
