Our School Council is made up of 2 members from each class in Year 1 and 2, with Year R joining us in the Summer Term. New members are elected onto the Council each Term.

We meet once a fortnight to talk about different school issues. Since January 2015 our School Council has been looking at ways of improving our school lunch times, both inside and outside. This has involved discussions around devising Playground Rules, improving table manners, how to avoid making a mess, and how to create an appealing eating space.

The School Council usually starts the discussions at their meetings and then takes questions to their classes to get some more ideas.
