English

In English, we will continue to practise writing compound sentences joining 2 ideas using the conjunctions and, so, but, because. We will start to add adjectives to our writing to make it more interesting. We will make sure our sentences are correctly punctuated with a full stop or question mark and capital letters for the beginning of the sentence as well as for names and places. We will start to learn about exclamation marks.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about habitats and will be thinking about how animals are adapted to their habitats. We will look for creatures that live on our school field and discuss the habitat. On our school trip, we will take part in pond dipping and look for creatures that live in a pond.

PSHE

Following our Jigsaw program we will be looking at 'Changing me'. This will help us think about changes in our bodies but also changes in our lives.

Things to do at home

- Continue to read regularly at home.
- Help your child use the correct past tense of verbs e.g. I rode not I rided. I swam not I swimmed.
- Practise your Year 1 spellings in particular List 3/4 and the common exception words
- Practise telling the time o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past
- Practise counting in 2s 5s and 10s forwards and backwards
- Practise counting to 100 forwards and backwards

Religious Education

In RE our focus will be Belonging. We will start by talking about groups we belong to ie our family, maybe a club. Then we will learn about John the Baptist baptising Jesus and discuss Baptism. Finally, we will learn about how Jewish people show they belong.
