Dear Parents,

Where did January go? I think you could be mistaken that it was washed away in all the rain we have had and I am certainly looking forward to more signs of spring as we step into February next week! It is quite amazing that despite the dull days, all of our classrooms remain exceptionally busy with lots of engaging learning and golden moments as we shared in our assembly this afternoon. In addition to this, this week Mrs Kirby and Miss Parsons were pleased to welcome five parents to their Coffee Morning for parents with children who have SEN; as always feedback was very positive and those who attended felt it was a valuable opportunity.

In terms of **governance**, on Wednesday morning our Assessment and Progress Committee, which included one of our new governors Mrs Makunura, met to share our anonymised analysis of internal data for the end of the Autumn Term following assessment, moderation and pupil progress meetings. Alongside parents receiving their child(ren)'s Learning Targets (Reception pupils) and Attainment Trackers with key targets (Year 1 and Year 2 pupils), one of this committee's key responsibilities is to monitor all of our data percentages across both of our schools and to challenge progress. Detailed analysis and strategic plans in terms of learning provision were discussed to further support all of our pupils to reach their academic potential across the curriculum.

I sincerely hope everyone has received my letter via email (attached) regarding arrangements for our **Spring Term Parents Evenings** after half term. As always and detailed in the letter we hope all parents will meet with their child(ren)'s class teacher(s) to discuss progress and next steps as we value our partnership working so highly. The process to book an appointment remains the same as before (via our Arbor App) which opens at 6.00pm on Monday evening, but as always, if you require any help regarding this please do not hesitate to pop in to the School Office, or give us a call and a member of the team will gladly assist you; there is so much to share and celebrate.

To end on a well-being note and looking ahead, I would like to share the wise words of the **'Friendly February' Calendar** from Action for Happiness; the focus is all about the theme of friendship and positively connecting with others. I believe that we all value our connections and support through friendships but sometimes we just need a little reminder of just how important and impactful they are!


## Bag2School Donations
