

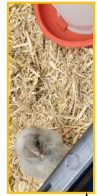
## A few reminders...

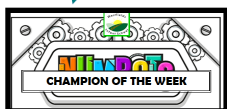
Hampshire & Isle of Wight Fire & Rescue Service have asked us to share this important reminder with all our families:
