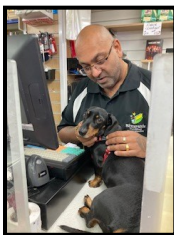
Welcome to the start of the new school year - what a busy (and rather soggy!) one it has been! I've been super busy in and out of school...

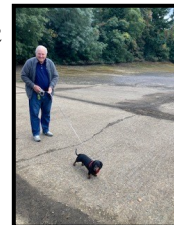
