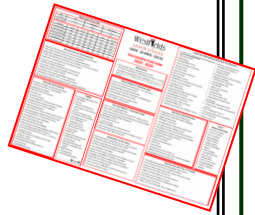
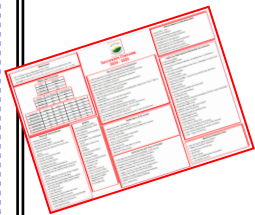


Parent Forum 2025
