World Earth Day Easter Holiday Challenge

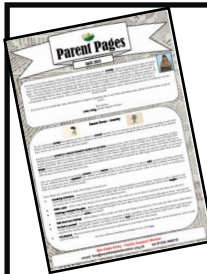
